9th February, Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time - C

Isaiah 6:1-8 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 Luke 5:1-11

This passage recounts Jesus calling Simon Peter, James, and John to follow Him. After a miraculous catch of fish, Simon Peter recognizes Jesus' divine authority, and the disciples leave everything to follow Him.

- Jesus often meets us in the ordinary moments of life, transforming them into opportunities for grace.
- Like Peter, we must acknowledge our unworthiness before God but still trust in His call.
- True discipleship requires leaving behind our attachments and following Jesus wholeheartedly.

16th February, Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time - C

Jeremiah 17:5-8 1 Corinthians 15:12.16-20 Luke 6:17.20-26

In this passage, Jesus delivers the Beatitudes and warnings. He contrasts blessings for the poor, hungry, and persecuted with woes for the rich, satisfied, and complacent.

- We are called to trust in God's providence, especially in times of struggle or suffering.
- Material wealth and comfort can distract us from our need for God and the needs of others.
- We must keep our eyes fixed on the promises of eternal life, even when the world tempts us to seek immediate gratification.

23rd February, Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time - C

Samuel 26:2....23 1 Corinthians 15:45-49 Luke 6:27-381

In this passage, Jesus commands His followers to love their enemies, forgive others, and give generously. He calls for radical love and mercy that mirrors God's own mercy toward us.

HOLY YEAR 2025 Bishop Alan has designated the Cathedral; Our Lady of Light Church in Clacton and St Anthony of Padua, Forest Gate as the three Churches to gain the Indulgence of the Holy Year. The Cathedral Holy Year Door is the original door of the 1860 Brentwood Church (located behind the choir stalls). If you are unable to make a Pilgrimage to Rome, you can be a Pilgrim to the Cathedral and enter through the Holy Door. The Jubilee Indulgence is a gift of grace granted by the Church. It involves the remission of all temporal punishment due to sin for those who are: Truly repentant and free from attachment to sin. Purified through the Sacrament of Penance.
