9th March, First Sunday of Lent - C Romans 10: 8-13

Deuteronomy 26: 4-10

In this passage, Jesus is led by the Spirit into the wilderness, where He is tempted by the devil for forty days. This narrative highlights Jesus' faithfulness and reliance on God's Word in overcoming temptation.

- Temptation in the Wilderness: Jesus faces and resists three temptations from the devil, each targeting His identity and mission.

- Scripture as a Weapon: Jesus combats each temptation with Scripture, demonstrating its power and authority.

- Victory Over Sin: Jesus' triumph over temptation foreshadows His ultimate victory over sin and death.

#### 16th March, Second Sunday of Lent - C

#### Genesis 15: 5-12, 17-18

Philippians 3: 17-4: 1

Luke 9: 28-36

Luke 4: 1-13

This passage recounts the Transfiguration, where Jesus is revealed in His divine glory to Peter, James, and John. It serves as a foretaste of His resurrection and a confirmation of His identity as the Son of God

- The Transfiguration reminds us that Jesus is both fully human and fully divine.

- We are called to listen to Jesus and follow His teachings, as the Father commands.

- The vision of glory strengthens our hope in the promise of eternal life.

23rd March, Third Sunday of Lent - C Corinthians 10: 1-6, 10-12

Exodus 3: 1-8, 13-151

Luke 13: 1-9 In this passage, Jesus addresses questions about suffering and repentance. He uses the parable of the fig tree to illustrate the importance of bearing fruit in our lives through repentance and conversion.

- Repentance is not just a one-time act but a continuous turning back to God.

- God's patience is an opportunity for growth, not a reason to delay conversion.

- We are called to examine our lives and ensure we are bearing fruit for God's kingdom.
