Jeremiah 23:1-6 Ephesians 2:13-18 Mark 6:30-34

Jesus is the true shepherd of his flock foretold by Jeremiah who is moved to pity for his people. He will gather all peoples to himself and bring reconciliation to a divided world. He is not like the false shepherds of Israel who scatter of the people of God. By the shedding of his blood, he has shown himself to be the true king exhibiting love, honesty and integrity.

28th July, Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - B

Kings 4:42-44 Ephesians 4:1-6 John 6:1-15

Jesus has taken an act like that of Elisha and added a new meaning. In feeding the five thousand he gives freely in such abundance that all comers were satisfied with plenty left over. In the Eucharist he has given us food for our journey in which our needs are satisfied. However, Paul reminds us that this gift demands that we act and be unity in the one body.
